**for the use of the work under open access conditions**

who is the author(s) of the work,  
(*title of the work*) (hereinafter referred to as the Work), hereinafter referred to as the **Licensor** (Licensors)) on the one hand and the **Institute of Electrodynamics of the NAS of Ukraine** represented by the **Director, Academician of the NAS of Ukraine Andriy Zharkin** acting based on the Charter (hereinafter referred to as the **Licensee**), to publish the Work in the **journal “Technical Electrodynamics”** (hereinafter referred to as the **Publication**), published by the Institute of Electrodynamics of the NAS of Ukraine, taking into account that this Agreement is a license agreement concluded in accordance with Articles 48, 50, 51 of the Law of Ukraine “On Copyright and Related Rights” and Articles 444, 1107–110 of the Civil Code of Ukraine, have concluded this Agreement on the following:

**1. Subject of the Agreement**

**1.1.** The Licensor grants the Licensee permission to produce and publish a copy of the Work in electronic (digital) and/or other form in the **journal “Technical Electrodynamics”**, published by the Institute of Electrodynamics of the NAS of Ukraine, in accordance with the rules for publication in the journal “Technical Electrodynamics”, determined by the Licensee. The Licensor(s) certify that they have not granted and will not grant permission to produce and publish a copy of the Work to another publisher; property rights to the Work have not been transferred to other persons, and no license to use the Work has been granted to other persons.

**1.2.** The Licensee carries out editorial and publishing processing of the manuscript of the Work and makes the published Work publicly available by placing a copy in electronic (digital) form on the Publication web resource and ensuring interactive access to the Work on the Internet or other interactive networks.

**1.3.** The use of the manuscript of the Work during editorial and publishing processing, publication of the Work, as well as the use of the published copy of the Work by the Licensor(s) and users is carried out under the terms of the **Creative Commons** open access license (hereinafter referred to as the **CC License**), the type of which is determined by the Regulations on Open Science at the NAS of Ukraine, approved by the order of the Presidium of the NAS of Ukraine dated 12.06.2024 No. 350, namely **CC BY-NC-ND (Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivs)**.

**1.4.** The methods of using the Work are determined by the CC License specified in clause 1.3 of this Agreement.

**1.5.** The territory of use of the Work is the territory of all countries of the world.

**1.6.** The term of granting the CC License is the term of validity of the intellectual property rights to the Work.

**1.7.** The Licensee has the right to conclude sublicense publishing agreements for the production and publication of a copy of the Work with other persons, if this is necessary for the publication of the Work in the Publication or for the publication of the Work in other countries.

**2. Disclaimer**

**2.1.** The Licensor declares that:

- a) the manuscript of the Work is original, he (they) is the author (co-author) of the Work;
- has been read and approved by all authors specified in the Agreement. Only contributors who have made a significant contribution to the manuscript are indicated as authors. All authors have approved the procedure for indicating the authors specified in the manuscript;
- has not been previously published;
- has not been submitted for consideration to any other scientific journal, and will not be submitted for consideration to another scientific journal during consideration of the Work in the Publication; The Work has not been made public before the date of submission of the manuscript of the Work to the Publication;

- does not contain information with restricted access
- confidential, secret and official information, in particular, state, commercial secrets, know-how; – does not contain unfounded or illegal statements;
- b) during the creation of the Work, the Licenser did not violate the intellectual property rights of other persons. If the Work contains materials of other persons, except for cases of citation to the extent justified by the scientific, informational or critical nature of the Work, the use of such materials is carried out by the Licenser in compliance with the norms of the law and the rules of citation;
- c) if the Work is official, the Licenser has been granted by his employer the right to enter into a license agreement with the publisher for the use of the Work for publication;
- d) if the Licenser's employer has established a procedure for reviewing official works before publishing them, the Licenser has agreed, in accordance with the procedure established by the employer, to publish the work;
- e) there is no conflict of interest. If a conflict of interest exists, the Licenser is obliged to inform the editorial board of the Publication of any private interest that could affect the presented results or their interpretation.

### **3. Other conditions**

- 3.1.** The copy of the Work, agreed upon by the Licensee and the Licenser(s), accepted for publication, is an integral annexe to this Agreement.
- 3.2.** Changes to the Work during the editorial and publishing processing of the manuscript of the Work are made by the Licensee in agreement with the Licenser(s).
- 3.3.** If the Work is to be published together with a reference to the research data required to confirm the research results presented in the Work, the Agreement shall specify a hyperlink (DOI object digital identifier) to such data in the open access information resource, namely:
- name of the research data;
  - hyperlink to the location of the research data.
- 3.4.** In the event of providing links to the published Work, the Licenser shall provide a hyperlink to the electronic copy of the published Work by indicating the DOI.
- 3.5.** If the type of license specified in clause 1.3 of this Agreement does not provide for the right to distribute derivative works, the editorial policy of the Publication may provide for the rules for distributing the translation of the Work in languages other than the language in which the Work was published. The Licensee shall also have the right to grant a public license for the distribution of the translation of the Work or to enter into sublicense agreements for the distribution of the translation of the Work.
- 3.6.** If the type of license specified in clause 1.3 of this Agreement provides for the use of the Work for non-commercial purposes, if the Licensee receives requests from persons regarding the use of the Work for commercial purposes, the Licensee has the right to conclude sublicense agreements with the specified persons regarding the use of the Work for commercial purposes.
- 3.7.** This Agreement is free of charge, except for cases where, in the event of the publication of the Work in journals published in foreign countries or other use of the Works, agreements between the Licensee and publishers or other persons provide for the payment of remuneration for the use of the Work, an additional agreement to this Agreement determines the terms and procedure for paying such remuneration to the Licenser.
- 3.8.** In a copy of the published Work, after the copyright mark, the Licensee - the publisher of the Work, or the publisher of the Work, to whom the NAS of Ukraine has granted the right to publish the Work and the right to indicate the publisher in the copyright mark based on a sublicense publishing agreement, shall be shown.
- 3.9.** In accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Personal Data Protection", the Licenser(s) consent to the Licensee's processing and provision to third parties of their personal data for the purpose of concluding and executing this Agreement and the Licensee's implementation of its obligations established by current legislation. The list of the Licenser's personal data, to which open access is provided and which are included in the metadata, the terms of use of personal data are determined by the Publication's policy on the use of personal data, posted on the Publication's web resource. The Licenser(s) confirm that they have been informed (without additional written notice) of the rights established by the Law of Ukraine "On Personal Data Protection", and their content is understandable.
- 3.10.** The Parties determine that in the case of the creation of the Work by co-authors, .....(full name of co-author) is the sole contact person during the publishing and editorial processing of the Work and is responsible for interaction with other co-authors regarding the processing of the Work during preparation for publication.

#### 4. Liability of the Parties

4.1. The Parties undertake to comply with the terms of this Agreement duly.

4.2 The Licensor (co-authors) shall be liable for violation of copyright, rights to information, and disclosure of restricted information. 4.3. All disputes that may arise between the Parties will be resolved through negotiations based on the current legislation of Ukraine and business practices. If it is impossible to resolve the disputed issues during the negotiations, the disputes shall be resolved in court.

#### 5. Term of the Agreement and Conditions for its Termination

5.1. The Agreement is valid from the date of its signing and is concluded for the term of validity of the intellectual property rights to the Work. If the Agreement is concluded, but the Work was not accepted for publication as a result of the review, the Agreement is considered terminated from the date the Licensee sends a notification to the Licensor's email address about the non-acceptance of the Work for publication.
